Talisman presented her film work on a panel at CAA conference, (Atlanta 2005) She was the first artist commissioned by the Magnes Museum (Berkeley, CA) to develop MATA/DATA, an online project (2008-09). Talisman moved to the Bay Area on August 11th 2001, where she lives and works, thanks to a day job, rent control, the two "Talented Artist" visas she was awarded by the US government (2004 & 2008), and finally, in 2010, a US Permanent Resident status as an "Artist of Exceptional Abilities".
